Tuesday | Sept. 10th | 11 AM

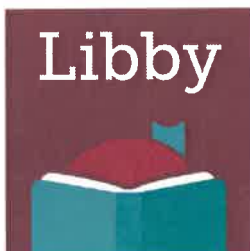

MOBILE HOTSPOTS

Mobile hotspots are devices that serve as a wireless access points for connecting devices to the internet. Hotspots allow you to connect a phone, a laptop, or a Roku to the Internet without having your own Internet service.



ROKU STREAMING DEVICES

A Roku streaming device is all you need to stream on your TV. It uses a WiFi connection to make every TV a smart TV. If you don't have home Internet, you can pair the Roku with a Mobile Hotspot you have checked out from the Library!



BLU-RAY DVD PLAYER

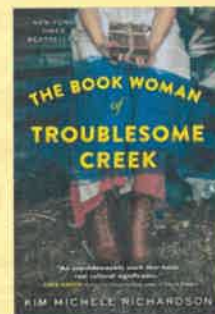

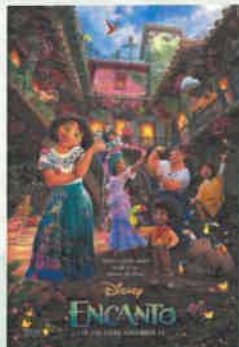


YOUTH PROGRAMS
