Since February 19, 2025, the Broadview Public Library District has been closed due to unexpected flooding. While our doors may have been temporarily shut, our commitment to serving our wonderful community never wavered. Behind the scenes, we have been diligently working to restore and enhance our space, and we are thrilled to finally welcome you back!

As a result of this challenge, we've taken the opportunity to make exciting improvements to BPLD. Our **IT modernization project** will introduce brand-new public computers, and we've installed a large screen in our **Adult Computer Commons** to offer expanded technology training classes. Additionally, thanks to the **Digital Navigator Incentive Program Grant**, we now have laptops available for in-library use, allowing patrons to book **self-guided technology assistance** in our private study rooms.

We're also making updates throughout the building! In the coming weeks, we will **relocate young adult graphic novels to the Teen Room** and enhance access to our **video gaming systems**. Downstairs, we are launching a **new Art Gallery** to showcase local artists, and our **Makerspace and Meeting Room** will soon be transformed into a more versatiled creative space for both active and passive programs.

All of these improvements will be completed in time for our Summer Reading Program kickoff on June 2nd, and we can't wait to share them with you! Thank you for your patience and support—we look forward to seeing you back at BPLD!
